

Hands-on at Home | Fizzing Snowballs

Follow the instructions below to experience snow indoors!

SUPPLIES

- Container of any size
- 1 cup Shaving Cream [Any brand is fine]
- 1 cup Baking Soda
- Glitter [Optional]
- Distilled White Vinegar

DIRECTIONS

- Take one cup shaving cream and one cup baking soda and combine it in your container. If you would like to make more of this mixture, it is a simple 1:1 ratio.
- Mix the shaving cream and baking soda together with your hands for some messy fun. You will mix until the “snow” in your hands is dry, but moldable. If it is too crumbly and dry, add more shaving cream. If it is too wet and sticking to your hands, add more baking soda.
- At this point, you can start playing with your indoor snow! You can add glitter for some extra sparkle. The snow should feel moist, crumbly, and stick together nicely. It might also feel cool to the touch, just like real snow! That’s because of the menthol in the shaving cream.
- To put the fizz in your fizzing snowballs, simply pour vinegar slowly over your snow. The vinegar and baking soda will react to create a fizzy foam.

CLEAN UP

Pour more vinegar over the mixture to dissolve it, then wash down the drain with hot water.
