Hands-on at Home | DIY Play Doh

Follow the instructions below to recreate play dough at home from start to finish in this fun hands-on experiment!

SUPPLIES

- 1 Cup | Flour (Add more if too runny, we used 2 cups in the end)
- 1/2 Cup |Table Salt
- 2 Tablespoons | Cream of Tartar
- 1 Tablespoon | Oil
- Mixing utensils
- 1 Cup | Boiling Water
- Food Coloring
- Measuring Tools
- Plastic Bag or Container to store
- Safety Glasses, if accessible

DIRECTIONS

- In a bowl, combine the flour, salt and cream of tartar. Mix well.
- Add the oil.
- Mix a few drops of food coloring into the boiling water and add to the bowl.
- Mix everything together very well with a mixing utensil and add aditional flour here if necessary, when the consistency is right, use your hands to mix until it is no longer sticky.
- Once it is fully cooled, wrap in plastic and put it in an airtight container. Store at about room temperature for about 6 months.

WARNING

Be careful when handling the boiling water as it will be very hot.
